

### **“3.” Analysis of requests on scheduling of new sectors of subsectors**

#### Services énergétiques

##### Japon:

- Japan requests that wide-ranging commitments be made on MA and NT in the sector of energy services, to the extent possible;
- Japan requests that commitment be made on a temporary entry and stay of natural persons who engage in business activities requiring the skills and/or knowledge in the field of energy on the basis of an employment contract with recipient companies within the recipient EC Member;
- In some of the EC member states, foreign energy service suppliers are differently treated in each region according to the different regional laws and regulations, which may hinder the development of energy market and trade in services in the field of energy. Japan therefore requests that central governments, including independent regulatory agencies of those member states, will harmonize those laws and regulations in order to reduce obstacles for foreign service suppliers.

##### Suisse

- all modes: undertake commitments reflecting the national legislation presently in force and covering all energy related services, excluding the nuclear sector.

##### USA:

- clarification of request for energy services
  - requests are neutral with respect to energy service and technology unless otherwise specified;
  - USA recognizes that energy is a vital public service.
  - This request does not apply to maritime transport services
- Request: take full MA and NT commitments in modes 1, 2, 3 in the sub-sectors listed below:
  - Exploration and development services;
  - Services incidental to energy distribution;
  - Energy marketing services – USA requests additional commitments with respect to access to, and use of, essential facilities for the transportation of the energy marketing services. Such additional commitments would take into account the need of members to impose public services obligations;
  - Other services important to energy services (voir listes).

#### **“4.” Analysis of requests on elimination of MFN exemptions**

Uruguay: eliminate all MFN exemptions.

Corée: remove all MFN exemptions

Brésil: eliminate the following MFN exemptions (exemptions 1 et 2).

Nouvelle-Zélande:

- movement of natural persons for the supply of services: terminate
- all other exemptions: replace “indefinite” with specified duration.

Japon:

- abolish all measures listed in MFN exemption list
- measures which falls within the scope of GATS Article V, VII, etc... be deleted from the list, in accordance with the Procedures for the certification of terminations of article II exemptions, as stipulated in S/L/106.

Mauritius

- exemptions must be terminated.
